Meeting Minutes

January 18th, 2016 the KRCA Meeting was called to order at 7:01 PM

Attendance: 9 members

Minutes of the previous meeting were voted on and accepted as published.

Membership: 55 members, 41 with current AMA and, 18 paid at time of meeting.

Treasurer Report: The treasurers report was read and accepted.

Old Business:

- 1. Runway fence expansion is complete. One fence is still needed to keep aircraft from flying into the pit area. It was discussed to add extensions on taxi barrier fence to protect he pit area. This is tabled until next meeting.
- 2. Construction of tents in pit area was discussed and a semi- permanent structure was not viable at this time and for members to bring heir own shade.
- Reciprocal use of members of other fields using the KRCA field was discussed and decided that as long as hey have a current AMA card and don't abuse the privilege it was OK for them to fly at the field. A current KRCA member must be present during the non-members flying.
- 4. Web site, Mike Hale ihas been communicating with Bob Ross to take over the website. It is decided that it would be better to create a new website instead, Mike will be working on getting that up and running. The new website will have permissions for officers and buy and sell items sections.
- 5. Camera on wrecking yard was discussed and was determined that it would not be a viable option as who was liable if the equipment went down or vandalized. The field is quite a distance from the wrecking yard and the condition of the field could no be made out.

New Business:

1. FAA Registration was brought to the attentions of all AMA members and at the time of the meeting it is determined for all members to register with the FAA. The cost of \$5 which will be returned until January 21st 2016. The deadline for FAA registration is February 21st. After that time it will be illegal to fly your model and

you could face criminal charges and fines. The club is not responsible for policing who is registered with the FAA as the FAA registration is a requirement between the FAA and individuals. For more information on the requirements please visit https://www.faa.gov/uas/registration/faqs

- 4. Calendar events for coming year was brought up and will be discussed more at the next meeting.
