Flying Field updates:

- 1. JB Sod field:
 - Maintenance on the lawn mower will be needed soon. Bob and David will get it done.
- 2. Mt. Angel Field
 - The seeded grass is growing well despite some rain erosion. My need to re-seed in spring.
 - The Dallas club will donate plastic mats for the pit area/pilot stations
 - Total expenditures so far are approx. \$400. Expected total investment should be about \$1200 when we are finished.





Old Business:

- 1. Field Security
 - Field security at JB Sod is still a concern, as several new instances of trespassing and unauthorized use have been noted.
 - Bob is still working with JB Sod about gated or controlled access to the field.
 - If you encounter someone at the field, politely and safely remind them it's for club use. Call the Sherriff if necessary.


- 2. FAA Reauthorization Act will bring changes for us in 2019.
