### Old Business:

#### 1. Holden – Bevens Field Update:

- The land use agreement with Holden is approved and signed.
- Holden has also approved our preliminary field layout and is still excited for us to use the facility more this spring.
- Current weather is the limiting factor for starting to move equipment from the JB Sod Field.
  - Plan to start moving 2/29 or as weather allows. Stay tuned for a more detailed plan.
  - The container will be one of the last things relocated. Fencing, tables, windsocks, etc. can be moved as the opportunity arises.
- Gopher control will be a hot issue this year.

## 2. AMA Grant Application

- The AMA Flying Site Improvement Grant was submitted before the February Deadline. Preliminary feedback to the draft application was positive.

### 2. Club Collaboration proposal

- Jerry has been working on a proposed collaboration plan with the surrounding clubs. It currently has some support, with further discussion happening in the other clubs.
- Proposal would be to create a non-voting membership class, which members of other clubs could use to join additional clubs at a discounted rate.
- KRCA would have to revise the bylaws to create a new membership class, but the membership feeling was receptive of the idea.
- Jerry will approach the other clubs with the proposal.

- Will likely be the last even at the JB Sod Field.
