- Jerry has been in contact with the AMA regarding the status of Remote ID & testing requirements which are coming
 - Currently the AMA claims good response to their advocacy efforts with the FAA
 - Knowledge test looks like a 25-questions online “no-fail” test which will be administered through the AMA and possibly others as well.
 - AMA is advocating for recognized fixed flying sites and an app-based solution when flying from other locations
 - Rule-making is still ongoing, changes will happen but current status is encouraging.
3. Continuing improvement for Holden/Bevens Field
- Electrical installation to our charging bench at Holden/Bevens field is done! We now have power and a workbench at the field.
