Old Business:

- Homer Davenport Days parade debrief
 - o Parade went very well, float was very popular

 - We had people come ad go before we were able to get to the field
 - o Flew 8 or 9 demo flights immediately after the parade

Clubhouse

- Interior is painted and looks great!

- Hobbyking support

 - They have agreed to support the club at a later date when business picks back up

- Web Cam and Weather Station
 - Components purchased, need to coordinate final installation location and time to install & set up
- Bathroom Improvements
 - Will replace the sink with a deeper style & move to the North wall
 - Replace the toilet
 - Improve the plumbing
 - Will revisit project in October and work throughout the winter
- Frequency Board
 - Doug Brown working on a simpler board than what we currently have
- Signage
 - AMA supplied two large sticker signs
 - Voted on proposed filed rules from August meeting:
 - Proposal of KRCA Field rules
 - Observe all AMA Safety rules
 - No smoking, no drinking
 - Safety lines notes (fence is the deadline, no flying over the pits or parking)
 - High Speed Passes over the road (not over the runway)
 - Pets must be on a leash
 - Only pilots & designated supervised crew in pits
 - Spotters are encouraged
 - Max 4 pilots in the air at same time
 - Pilots to announce their intentions to other pilots
 - Observe posted speed limits on the driveway
 - Field Rules approved as listed (addition of "Observe AMA Safety Rules" to the August listed rules)
- Club Combat
 - Assassin wings purchased and distributed
 - Scheduled "Build Parties" at the clubhouse Sept. 11, 12, evening of the 13th
 - Make sure all of your equipment is ready to install for the build days!
- Need to revamp/refurbish our A-Frame wood signs
 - Doug Brown working on them
